



AUTOMATED APPEAL IN TENNISLINK

Who Can appeal?

- 1) Computer rated players – Up or Down
- 2) Mixed Exclusive – Up or Down
- 3) Self-rate who wish to move UP only

NOTE: BENCHMARK players (“B”) cannot appeal UP or DOWN for one year

What must be referred/heard by the Section or their designee? Contact Lindsey Sartain, Director of Adult League programs at lindseys@mstennis.com for the following appeal types.

- 1) Self-rated who wish to move DOWN
- 2) All medical appeals
- 3) Already APPEALED ratings

STEP ONE: Go to www.mstennis.com and select “Leagues” under Tennis Link.

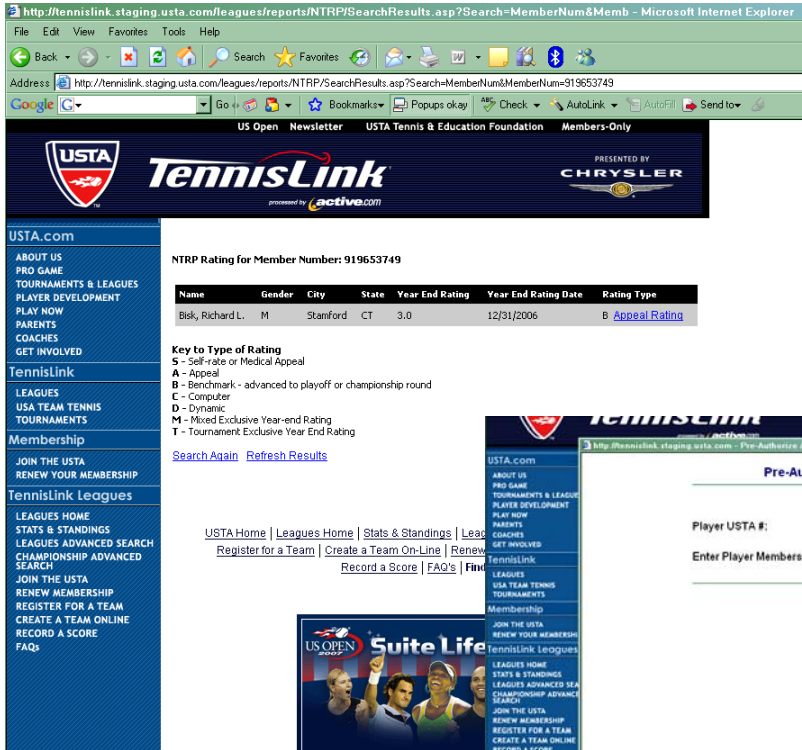
STEP TWO: On Tennis Link on the right-hand side select “Find a Rating”

STEP THREE: Enter your USTA# (name only won’t work).

THEN JUST FOLLOW THE ON-SCREEN INSTRUCTIONS AND READ CAREFULLY ALL INFORMATION CONCERNING YOUR APPEAL

Player must **search by USTA#** in order to see appeal option.

“Appeal Rating” option will be visible IF the rating can be appealed through “Find A Rating.”



CLICK on “Appeal Rating”

Individual must enter their zip code as it appears in Membership.

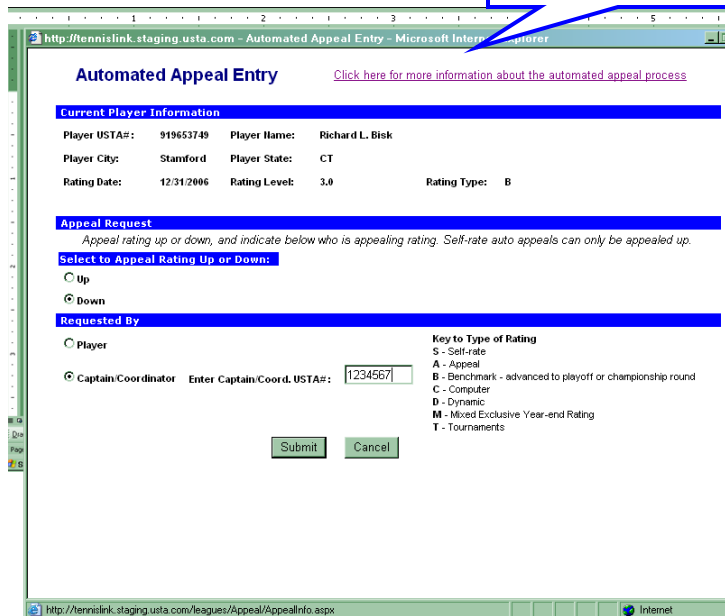
Player may review Reasons appeals will be granted

Player will then be asked if they wish to appeal . . .

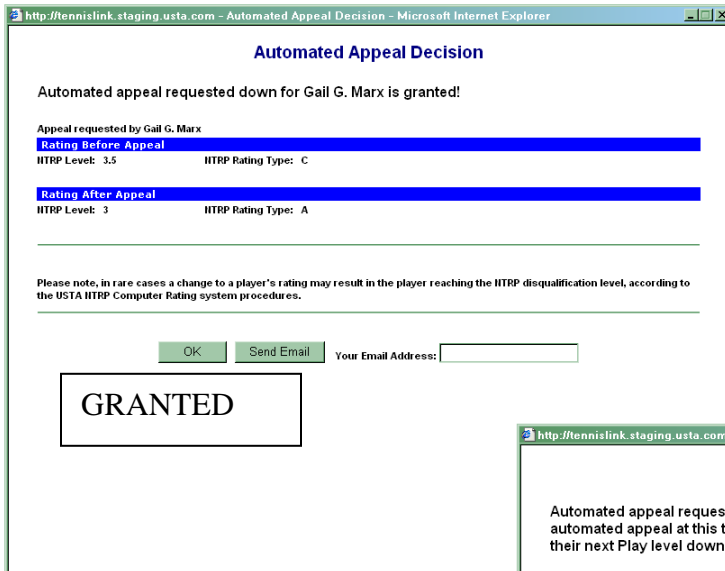
UP or Down

If requested by Captain/Administrator, they must provide their USTA#.



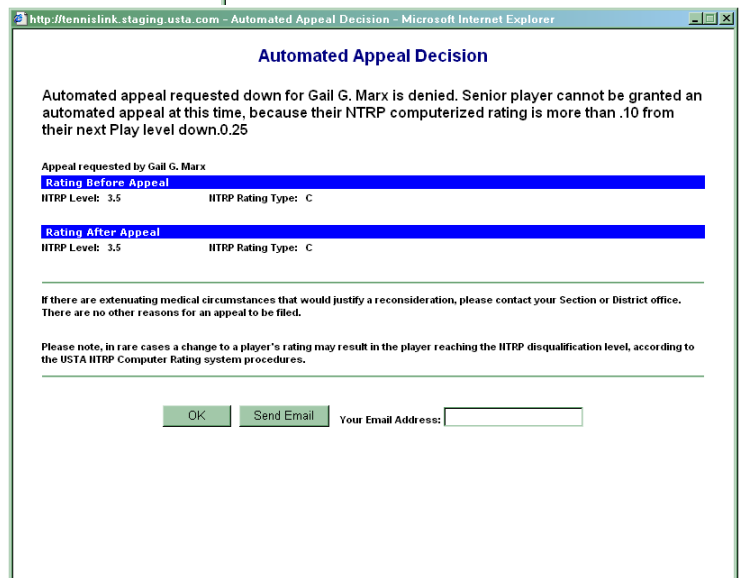
SUBMIT

If Denied there is an explanation provided based on the Regulations and NTRP Methodology reasons for granting an appeal.
