

Junior Awards:

1. Dorothy Vest Junior Players of the Year – Male And Female.
Presented to outstanding junior players who holds a ranking in the 18 & under divisions in recognition of their tennis performance at the state, sectional and national levels.

2. George Wilkinson Memorial Award – Male And Female.
Presented to outstanding junior players (boy and girl) who exemplify the qualities of composure under physical stress and emotional discipline in recognition of his and her desire, integrity, perseverance, maturity, character (on and off the court), conduct and appearance.

3. Powers Moore Junior Sportsmanship Award.
Presented to an outstanding junior player (boy or girl) ranked in the state in recognition of his or her sportsmanship.

4. Coach of the Year.
Presented to an outstanding high school or college coach in recognition of leadership and inspiration in the development of a winning program.

5. Junior Tournament of the Year.
Presented to a junior tournament in recognition of excellence in the organization and conduct of a sanctioned event.

6. Junior Team Tennis Sportsmanship.
Presented to a boy and girl player who played on a *USTA* Junior Team in Mississippi in recognition of his and her good sportsmanship by teammates, opponents, and team manager.

Adult Tournament Players Awards:

1. Female Player of the Year.

Presented to an outstanding adult female ranked in the state in recognition of her tennis performance and sportsmanship.

2. Male Player of the Year.

Presented to an outstanding adult male ranked in the state in recognition of her tennis performance and sportsmanship.

3. Womens Doubles Team of the Year. Presented to an outstanding women's doubles team ranked in the state in recognition of their tennis performance and sportsmanship.

4. Mens Doubles Team of the Year.

Presented to an outstanding men's doubles team ranked in the state in recognition of their tennis performance and sportsmanship.

5. Mixed Doubles Team of the Year.

Presented to an outstanding mixed doubles team ranked in the state in recognition of their tennis performance.

6. Adult Tournament of the Year.

Presented to an adult tournament in recognition of excellence in the organization and conduct of a sanctioned event.

7. official of the Year.

Presented to a certified official in recognition of outstanding contributions to the cause of tennis officiating in Mississippi.

League Tennis Awards:

1. Adult Team of the Year.

This award is presented to the captain of an adult men or women's local team that advanced to the state championship, in recognition of the team's tennis performance and sportsmanship during the tournament.

2. Senior Team of the Year.

This award is presented to the captain of a senior men or women's local team that advanced to the state championship, in recognition of the team's tennis performance and sportsmanship during the tournament.

3. Adult Mixed Doubles Team of the Year.

This award is presented to the captain of an adult mixed doubles local team that advanced to the state championship, in recognition of the team's tennis performance and sportsmanship during the tournament.

4. Senior Mixed Doubles Team of the Year.

This award is presented to the captain of a senior mixed doubles local team that advanced to the state championship, in recognition of the team's tennis performance and sportsmanship during the tournament.

5. Local League Coordinator of the Year.

This award is presented to a local league coordinator in recognition outstanding coordination and promotion of league play.

Special Awards:

1. Handicapped Player of the Year.
Presented to an outstanding player in recognition of her tennis performance and sportsmanship.
2. Special Tennis Event of the Year.
Presented to a tennis event other than a sanctioned or state championship tournament in recognition exemplary promotion and support of tennis.
3. Charity Tennis Event of the Year.
Presented to a tennis event that donates its proceeds to a philanthropic cause in recognition of excellence in the organization and conduct of the event.
4. Team Tennis Event of the Year.
Presented to an Adult League Championship tournament or event, USA Team Tennis for Youth state tournament or event, a USA Team Tennis for Adults state tournament or event, or a Collegiate Team Tennis state tournament or event in recognition of excellence in the organization and conduct of the event.
5. Education Merit Award.
Presented to an individual who has who has developed an outstanding tennis program that provides leadership and inspiration in junior programs for schools, colleges, parks and playgrounds benefiting the growth of tennis in Mississippi.
6. Media Award.
Presented to an individual or organization who/which disseminates information to the general public in recognition of his/her/its contributions to tennis in Mississippi and the sport in general.
7. Member Organization of the Year.
Presented to a member organization of the MTA in recognition of outstanding service to the local community, to the organization members, and to the game of tennis.
8. Family of the Year.
Presented to a family in recognition of outstanding contributions in the promotion of tennis in Mississippi.
9. Volunteer of the Year.
Presented to a volunteer in recognition of outstanding service at the local, state, sectional and/or national levels.
10. Tennis Professional of the Year.
Presented to a certified tennis professional in recognition of quality USTA programming for adults and/or youth.
11. Community Tennis Association of the Year.
Presented to a Community Tennis Association in recognition of outstanding service in the administration of local tennis programs and the promotion of tennis at the community level.
