

Format/Championship Rules

- Matches will be the best of 2 sets regular scoring with a match tiebreak (first to 10 by 2) used in lieu of a third set. When a set reaches 6 games all a set tiebreak (first to 7 by 2) will be used to determine the set. The Coman tiebreak will be used.
- A fifteen minute default time and point penalty system for lateness will be in effect. Please review the **point penalty system**. The referee is responsible for issuing any penalties.
- Line-ups on scorecards can only be changed through substitution in the event of injury, illness, no-show, or personal emergency of a player prior to the start of the individual match. In the event of a known default, the opposing team may adjust its lineup.
- The tournament committee reserves the right to alter format, scoring, surface, site location, and scheduling as it deems necessary.
- Players must have played in at least 1 match locally or received one default in order to participate unless teams are advancing directly due to having no local competition. Retirements count as a match played. Captains are responsible for insuring players have qualified.
- Players must have a current USTA membership. Captains are responsible for insuring current membership.
- Players may participate on more than one team during state championship play.
